



Fundraising Public Compliance Statement

- Aware is committed to complying with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and has formally discussed and adopted the statement at a meeting of the board of directors.
- Aware confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- Aware has a donor charter which is consistent with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.
- Aware regularly monitors compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body.
- Aware considers the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* when planning all fundraising activity.
- Aware has a policy on working with third-party fundraisers.
- Aware provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- Aware has appointed a member of the governing body and/or a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.
- Aware ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and its implementation.
- Aware has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and board of directors. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- Aware prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- Aware ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and comply with data protection requirements.
- Aware is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
