Principal duties:

- Be a member of the Aware Clinical Committee of the Board of Directors of Aware with oversight of clinical governance of the organisation.
- Provide Clinical advisory services to the CEO, Director of Services, the Clinical Committee of the Board of Directors of Aware and the Directors of Aware, as required.
- Contribute to the strategic planning and achievement of strategic goals of Aware.
- Take a leading role in creating and developing Aware programmes in conjunction with the Director of Services
- Lead the translation of research into practice in the areas of depression and bipolar disorder and evaluate all that translation.
- Develop and have clinical oversight of a research strategy for the organisation.
- Advise on and have clinical oversight on all clinical content of education programmes, support services, information services and literature delivered and circulated by Aware.
- Advise on clinical aspect of all service delivery.
- Advise on developments in best international practice specific to the service delivery areas being addressed by Aware.
- Advise on the application of best international clinical practice and governance to the Aware services.
- Be a member of the Aware Safety Audit and Risk Management committee.
- Lead and facilitate media interviews as appropriate to represent Aware. Take a proactive approach to raising the profile of Aware by active engagement with the media.
- Provide expertise and advice on the use of recognised tools for formal evaluation of Aware services and programmes.
- Provide expertise in relation to all clinical policies.
